As part of our continuing effort to broaden your child's education, Secaucus High School will be continuing with the Summer Reading Program. The purpose of this program is to provide students with the opportunity to read for pleasure and enrichment during the summer months. Advanced Placement Literature students have an alternate reading assignment as a replacement for this project. Students taking Advanced Placement Language and Composition must complete this assignment **in addition to** the teacher-assigned project.

SHS students will receive a list of approved websites of book titles and two Reader's Guide Forms prior to the end of the school year.

The **mandatory assignment** for SHS's Summer Reading Program is as follows:

- Upon reviewing the suggested websites, students will select **two books to read**. If no titles on these websites interest them, then students may choose other titles with your guidance and approval.
- Students will complete a Reader's Guide Form for **each book**.
- These two **completed Reader's Guide Forms** will be collected based on the student's grade:
 - **Forms for Grades 9 and 10 will be collected on September 15, 2009.**
 - **Forms for Grades 11 and 12 will be collected on September 17, 2009.**
- Your signature, as well as your child's must be on each form to ensure completion of each reading selection and assignment.
